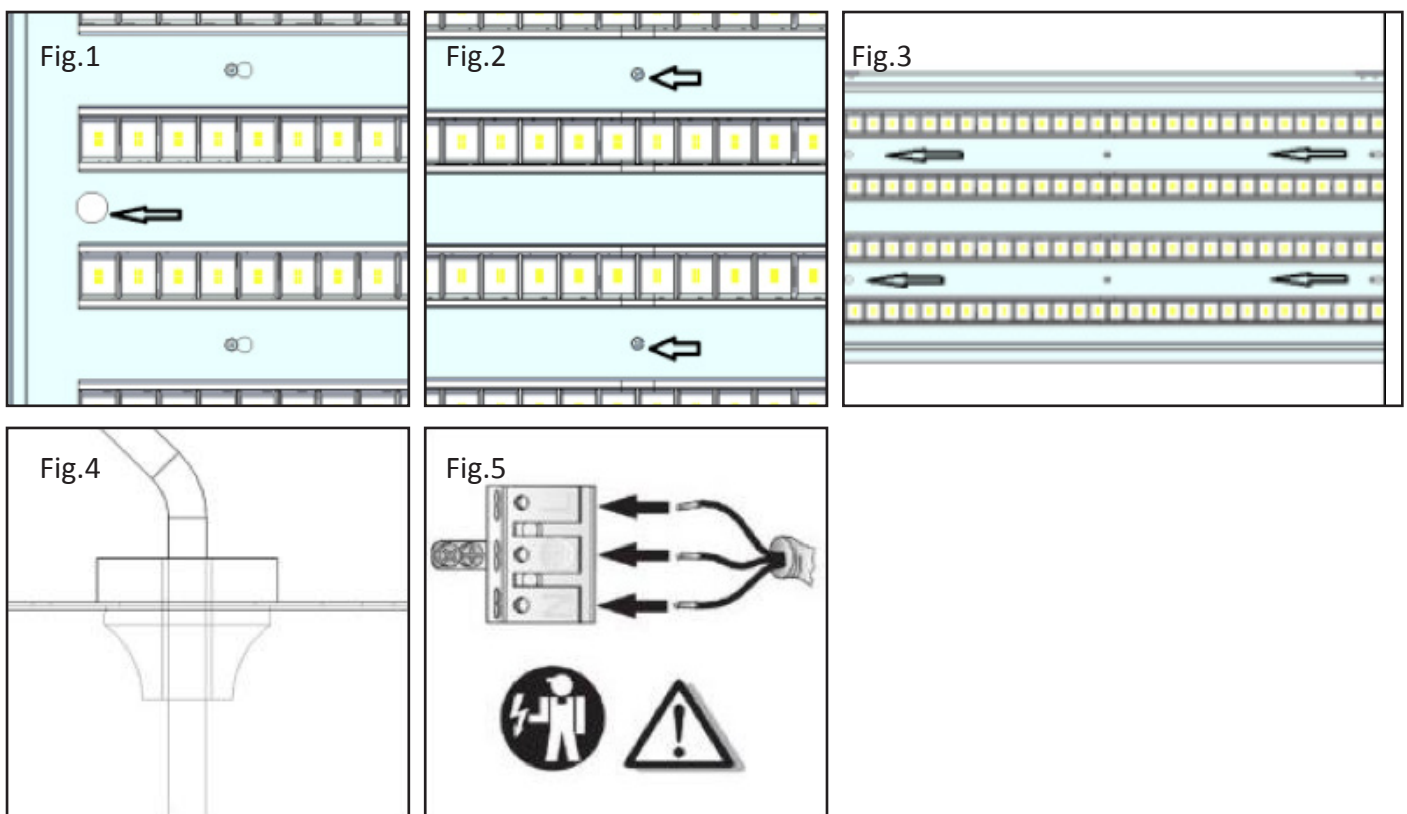




INSTRUCTIONS

- a) Isolate the electrical circuit
- b) Open the luminaire using a screwdriver
- c) Remove the caps as indicated in Fig.1
- d) Unscrew the two screws in the middle of the louvre structure (Fig.2)
- e) Loosen the four remaining screws in the louvre structure and move it as indicated in Fig.3
The structure will hang on lines.
- f) Disconnect the electric cables from the louvre structure
- g) Detach the clip hooks from the louvre structure and put in a safe place
- h) Attach the gland in the cable feeding hole and pull the cable through the gland (Fig.4)
- i) Screw the luminaire to the ceiling. The luminaire is fixed at 6 fixed holes according to the spacing indicated on the adjacent drawing.
- j) Connect the cable as indicated on the power terminal (Fig.5)
- k) Attach the cables and clip hooks to the louvre structure
- l) Re-install the louvre, attach the caps and close the luminaire



IMPORTANT WARNINGS

Do not install the luminaire in areas without sufficient air circulation. The manufacturer cannot be considered liable for any damage caused by inappropriate use of the luminaire other than its manufactured purpose.

Luminaries must be installed by a qualified registered electrician only. Any misuse of the luminaire when power is activated may cause the risk of an electric shock.

The manufacturer does not accept any responsibility of any issues resulting from the non-compliance of the recommendations included in this instruction document. These instructions are issued as a guide to assist the installer to satisfactory conclusion.
